Sakurajima Ferry YORIMICHI CRUISE

Enjoy the view of *Sakurajima* and *Kinko* bay from a ferry.

It is about a 50 minute cruise and it departs *Sakurajima* Ferry Terminal at 11:05 everyday. The ferry goes around *kurose* and off *Taisho* lava looking at *Sakurajima* and the city, so you can enjoy *Sakurajima* from different angles.

On the ferry they have a sightseeing announcement service and you can get discount services off hotels and shops in *Sakurajima*.

Udon noodles on the ferry is recommended.

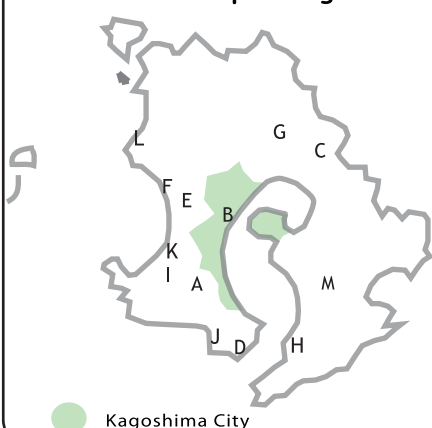

Retro Train "*Shiokaze-go* (sea breeze)" runs between Retro area, *Moji* port and *Mekari* area where you can see *Kanmon Straits*. Only from March 17th (Sat) to November 25th (Sun). It takes 10 minutes, and it stops at *Kyushu Railway History Museum (Kyushu Tetsudo Kinen-kan)* Station, *Idemitsu Museum of Arts (Idemitsu Bijutsu-kan)* Station, *Norfolk Hiroba* Station and *Kanmon Straits Mekari* Station. 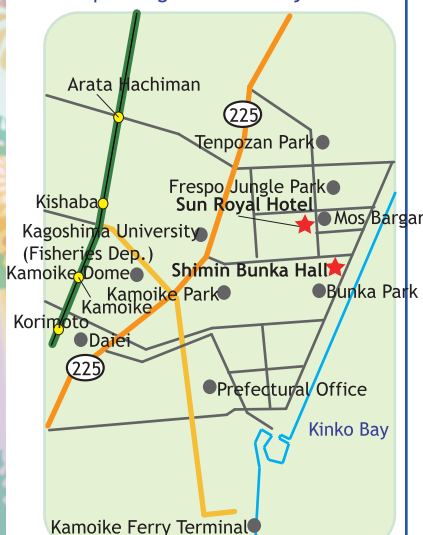

The basic philosophy of Satsuma

Jissinko Iroha-uta (日新公いろは歌) vol.29

Iroha-uta is originally a Japanese short poem. It is a perfect pangram, containing each character of the Japanese syllabary (hiragana) exactly once.
Jissinko iroha-uta are 47 poems each of which begin, respectively, with the original iroha poems first syllabary.

They also became the spirit of Goju kyoiku (郷中教育: The Satsuma education system).

The twenty-ninth poem (starting with the letter "や"):

やはらぐと怒るをいはばろと筆 鳥にふたつのつばさを知れ
(Yawaragu-to Ikaru-wo Iwaba Yumi-to Fude)

Tori-ni Futatsu-no Tsubasa-towo Shire)

Gentleness and strictness are like scholarship and the martial arts. Both of them are important. It is also like birds have two wings, and they need both wings to fly. Good leaders should know when to use gentleness and strictness.



はづき

葉月 (hazuki)

Japanese has a different name for each month. We call August “*hachi-gatsu*” usually, but we also have another name “*Hazuki*”. Some people say that the name means leaves (*ha*) fall (*Hazuki* is around the end of September to the first of October by the solar calendar). Others say that it means the rice growing (*haru*) season or the first (*hatsu*) month in which wild geese come.

Hazuki Calendar

八朔 (Hassaku)

August 1 (Wed)

Hassaku is the 1st of August according to the lunar calendar.

Early-ripening variety of rice crop around this time of the year, and there was a custom in which people gave the first ears of rice to their benefactors. From this custom this day is also called “*Tanomi-no Sekku* (田の実の節句 / fruits of the rice field festival)”.

立秋 (Risshu)

August 7 (Tue)

The first day of autumn by the old calendar. The season that you can feel a sign of autumn starts. By the old calendar, it is autumn from this day. But, of course it's still very hot. Actually, the hottest season of the year.

終戦記念日 (Shusen Kinenbi)

August 15 (Wed)

The anniversary of the end of the war. Japan made an unconditional surrender on this day, 1945.



Hagi (Bush clover)

Hagis bloom around *shosho*. It is one of the seven flowers of autumn. This flower has been loved in Japan since long ago. In *Heian* period, people used to write poems (*waka*) and give them to people whom they loved. The letter was tied with a twig of *hagi*.

お盆 (Obon)

August 13 (Mon) - 16 (Thu)

Japanese people think that the souls of their family members who died come back on these days. People light lanterns and go to the grave in the evening on the first day of the *Bon* Festival to welcome back departed souls. They also light a small fire at the gate which is supposed to be a guide for departed souls. The souls stay in their family's house on the 14th and 15th and go back to the after world on the 16th night. This time people light fires to speed the spirits back to the other world. In *Tokyo*, *Yokohama*, *Hakodate* and *Kanazawa*, *Obon* festival is held around July 15th, but it is held in August in provinces. Floating lanterns for the spirits of the dead is a custom in *Kita-kyushu* at the end of *Bon* festival. *Bon* festival dance is the dance for welcoming and seeing off the departed souls. Traditional midyear gift-giving (*ochugen*) used to be the present for relatives when people visit them during *obon* season.



処暑 (Shosho)

August 23 (Thu)

Shosho means the heat stops. The season of bushclovers and grains. It is still very hot in the daytime, but you can get cooler air at night. It is also the season of typhoons.

二百十日 (Nihyaku-toka)

August 31 (Fri)

The two hundred and tenth day from the first day of spring (*risshun* / 立春). People say that typhoons tend to come around this day.

* The dates above depend on the lunar calendar, so they change every year.

Nihyaku-toka

It is said *Harumi Shibukawa* (1639 ~ 1715), a scholar of the study of calendars adopted “*Nihyaku-toka*”, the day typhoons tend to come around this day, when he compiled *Jokyo* Calendar.

This day is one of the big three evil days with *Nihyaku-hatsuka* (the 220th day from the first day of spring) and *Hassaku* (the 1st of August according to the lunar calendar) for farmers. Because it is said typhoons tend to come around these days.

Why Shibukawa adopted this idea in the calendar?

There is a story which says that *Shibukawa* used to love fishing. One day, he was about to sail out to the sea of *Edo-shinagawa*. An old fisherman spotted a cloud in above the sea and said “According to my 50 year experience as a fisherman, It is likely that we will have stormy weather today, the 210th day from the first day of spring.” And, it was true. Then, *Shibukawa* found out that the following years were the same. But, this story is in conflict with the truth. *Shibukawa* was born in 1639, but this day is already in a record which was written in 1634.

However, this day has been said of typhoon attack day since *Edo* era.

Is it true?

Nihyaku-toka is around September 1st in the solar calendar. Were there many typhoons here in our history? The answer is No. Typhoons tend to come at the end of August and the middle of August.

This year many typhoons have come near Kagoshima. Whenever they come, please take care of yourselves.

Fortune-telling

August 1 ~ August 31
