Chiran (知覧) is called little Kyoto which means stores and houses on street look like and have an atmosphere similar to Kyoto. The samurai village in Chiran will make you feel as if you had been transported to the Edo era. The houses and the street are kept as they were since the Edo era. You can walk around seven gardens there. Those gardens incorporate background landscape into the composition of the gardens (borrowed scenery / 借景). Feel old Japan here in Chiran.

Samurai houses and gardens which were built about 250 years ago. 7 gardens with arranged stones and beautiful shaped trees are famous. Gates of houses, stone walls and hedges remain with the atmosphere of a village in the *Edo* period.

This house is unique to *Chiran*. The main building and the auxiliary building are connected and attached by a little ridge on the two buildings.

There is a shop in the building and they sell green tea and sweets. You can enjoy *Kagoshimas*' sweets such as *getanha* (a hard cake made with wheat flour, brown cane sugar, eggs and honey), *akumaki* (a traditional rice cake, glutinous rice soaked in lye overnight, wrapped in bamboo leaves and steamed) here. You can take sweets away, too.



Ice cream at a ramen shop? And Sweet potato Ice cream?

Yes! It is recommended!

Ramen Sansui is a restaurant at the end of the Samurai Village Street (near the free car park), and the building is just like other samurai houses. Sitting in a samurai house and feeling time slowly passing is very relaxing.

They serve ramen with soup based on pork bone and pork meat, and the taste is light. They also sell ice cream in summer and sweet potatoes in winter.

The most recommended ice cream is the sweet potato ice cream. Its color is lavender. It is not too sweet, mild and you can taste the beautiful flavor of sweet potato. Since you are

in Kagoshima, Japan's biggest producer of sweet potato, you should try it!

The basic philosophy of Satsuma

Jissinko Iroha-uta (日新公いろは歌) vol.30

Iroha-uta is originally a Japanese short poem. It is a perfect pangram, containing each character of the Japanese syllabary (hiragana) exactly once. Jissinko iroha-uta are 47 poems each of which begin, respectively, with the original iroha poems first syllabary.

They also became the spirit of Goju kyoiku (郷中教育: The Satsuma education system).

The twenty-ninth poem (starting with the letter "ま"):

万能も一心とあり事ふるに身ばし頼むな思案堪忍

(Mannou-mo Issin-to Ari Tsukauru-ni

Mibashi Tanomuna Shian Kannin)

As the proverb says even if one is talented at many things, without one's sincerity this is worthless. When you serve your master, do not show off your abilities. Think carefully, be modest and be tolerant.

長月(nagatsuki)

Japanese has a different name for each month. We call September "ku-gatsu" night becomes longer.

The traditional East Asian calendars divide a year into 24 solar terms (24節気). Hakuro (白露; white dew) is the 15th solar term.

The season Japanese pampas grass comes into fields, and the air feels more autumnal.

重陽の節句 (Choyo-no Sekku)

September 9 (Sun)



"Choyou" means there are two positive numbers. September 9th has a double 9. In times past in China, people said odd numbers are positive (lucky) numbers, and 9 is the extreme of the positive numbers, so it is called "Choyo". Chinese thought it a very happy day, and they had a custom to drink chrysanthemum sake, which invokes long life.

This custom came to Japan in the early Heian period (around AD 800). Chrysanthemum-viewing parties were held at the Imperial Court. It is also called Chrysanthemum festival (Kiku-no Sekku) or Chrysanthemum Party (Kiku-no Utage).

敬老の日 (Keiro-no-hi)

September 17 (Mon)

Respect for the Aged Day. It is a national holiday. The third Monday in September.

秋の彼岸 (Aki-no-higan)

September 19 (Wed) - 25 (Tue)

It is the period of three days before and after the autumnal equinox.

It becomes cooler around "higan", which means another world. It originally means spiritual enlightenment in Buddhism, but "higan" as a custom is traditionally Japanese. People go to their ancestor's graves and put rice cakes covered with bean jam, dumplings and other things on their household shrines.

秋分の日 (Shubun-no-hi)

September 22 (Sat)

Autumnal Equinox Day. It is a national holiday. It is in the middle of "higan", so this is also the day to respect ancestors and remember people who died.



* The dates above depend on the lunar calendar, so they change every year.

HARVEST MOON VIEWING

September 30 (Sun)



n Japan, since the *Heian* period people among the noble class started to enjoy admiring the moon on the Lunar 15th of August. This custom came from China.

Moon viewing became popular among citizens in the Edo period. Since then people have put Japanese pampas, dumplings and other things on the porch and other places where they can see the moon, and enjoy moon-viewing.

 T he decorations are various, depending on the place. Usually, people offer dumplings which look like the full moon and Japanese pampas grass where they can see the moon.

In Kagoshima, some districts still have the custom that everyone from children to old people gather on this night and sumo-wrestle and play at tug-of-war.

The Lunar 15th of August is usually from the end of September to early October in the solar calender.

In Japan, people used to say that if you see the harvest moon, you have to see the moon on the lunar 13th of September (October 27th this year), or it is inauspicious.

*The lunar 15th of August is the harvest moon, it is not always the full moon. This year the full moon is the same day as the harvest moon.

In autumn and winter, the air is the most dry and clear of the year, so you can see the moon very clearly. Also, in Autumn it is not so chilly even at night time.

For these reasons, people started to have the custom of moon viewing.

The harvest moon is called "Chushu-no-Meigetsu" or "Jugo-ya". "Chushu-no-Meigetsu" means "the beautiful moon on the middle day of August in the lunar calender". "Jugo-ya" also means "the middle day of the month in the lunar calender (in this case the middle day of August". Yes, Japanese people say that the Lunar 15th of August is the night that we can see the most beautiful moon of the year!
