THE GIRLS FESTIVAL ~ A SEASONAL FESTIVAL OF PEACH BLOSSOM ~



 $\it T$ he 3rd of March is the girl's festival. People decorate $\it Hina$ dolls and invoke their daughter's good health and growth.


But, originally this event was not for girls. It originated in China. Around AD 300, an event "Joshi-setsu (上巳節)" was begun. "Joshi (Jomi / 上巳)" means the day of the Snake (the sixth of the twelve signs of the Chinese zodiac) early in March. People used to think that devils tend to come inside of houses or their bodies when the seasons change, so they used to purify themselves at the waterside.

Japanese envoys to China during the Tang Dynasty brought this custom back to Japan. Japanese people had a custom of purifying themselves with water before that, and these two customs were merged.

Later, people started to hold "Kyokusui-no En (曲水の宴 / providing poems in front of a stream)" as an event for purification on Joshi. They also started another custom in which they transfered their uncleanliness and bad luck into dolls made with paper, straw and grass (tachi-bina), and floated them away.

This custom spread throughout the samurai class, and the Tokugawa shogunate established "Joshi-no Sekku (上巳の節句 / the seasonal festival of Joshi)" as one of five seasonal festivals. Then, this day became "The Girl's Festival (Hina-matsuri / 雛祭り)" as opposed to "The Boy's Festival" which is held on the 5th of May.

People also used to make dolls to keep evil spirits away from their children.



On the other hand, in the *Heian* period, girls from the noble classes used to play with paper dolls (Hina / *Hiina asobi*). "Hina (雛)" means small and cute things.

Later, people begun to make a pair of a man and a woman doll to remove their bad luck into. Doll making skill progressed, and gorgeous dolls started to be made. People started to decorate the dolls rather than float them away. Upper-class people started to give gorgeous hina dolls as one of a bride's household effects, and people liked the dolls in wedding costumes and with wedding tools.

The Tokugawa shogunate established "Joshi-no Sekku (the seasonal festival of Joshi)" as one of five seasonal festivals, and Hina dolls became a symbol of the financial power of the family. Thus people started to buy hina dolls to remove baby girls' bad luck, and celebrate the girls' festival, invoking their good health and growth.

Around the Edo period people dreamed of visiting the shrine, but traveling to Ise city in Mie prefecture cost a lot and people couldn't afford it. Therefore the community was established. People decided who goes to the shrine by lots or by turns. Later, people built a shrine in the area and started to have a festival instead.

The basic philosophy of Satsuma

Jissinko Iroha-uta (日新公いろは歌) vol.35

Iroha-uta is originally a Japanese short poem. It is a perfect pangram, containing each character of the Japanese syllabary (hiragana) exactly once. Jissinko iroha-uta are 47 poems each of which begin, respectively, with the original iroha poems first

They also became the spirit of Goju Kyoiku (郷中教育: The Satsuma education system).

The thirty-third poem (starting with the letter "て"):

敵となる人こそはわが師匠ぞとおもひかへして身をもたしなめ

(Teki-to Naru Hito-kosowa Waga Sisho-zoto

Omoi Kaeshite Mi-womo Tashiname)

Your enemy is actually your master. When you think about it, he gives you the stimulous to refine yourself. So, consider this and enhance yourself.

_{きさらぎ} 如月(Kisaragi)

Japanese has a different name for each month. We call February, "Ni-gatsu" usually, but we also have another name "Kisaragi". About the meaning of "Kisaragi" there are several opinions. Some people say it is the month of regeneration of grass and trees and others say it is the season that people wear more clothes.

Kisaragi calendar

立春 (Risshun)

February 4 (Mon)

The start of the year and spring in the lunar calendar. People say from this day the weather gets warm.

針供養 (Hari Kuyo)

February 8 (Fri)

It is a custom in which people hold a memorial service for broken needles. In the *Kansai* area, this is held on the 8th of December.

In days past, needlework was indispensable for women, so appreciating the value of needles and holding a memorial service for them was an important event.

Now, this custom is held only by people who use them for their work. They stick needles in *tofu* or *konnyaku* and pray for improvement of sewing. Then the needles are offered at a household shrine altar. After that people purify the offering by floating it downriver to the sea, or taking it to a shrine.

初午 (Hatsu-uma)

February 9 (Sat)

Hatsu-uma is the first day of the Horse in February. It is the day of the Inari shrine festival. Inari shrine is where the god of the harvest is worshiped. You can see fox statues in front c messenge is shrines.

建国記念の日 (Kenkoku kinen no hi)

February 11 (Mon)

According to "Nihon Shoki" the oldest Japanese book, Jinmu tenno became the first emperor on this day in 666 BC. It became a national holiday in 1967 as the day of "considering the foundation of the country and cultivating the mind for a patriotic spirit".

雨水 (Usui)

February 18 (Mon)

"Usui" means "the season the snow changes into rain and ice changes into water".

People start to prepare for farming

SETSUBUN (節分)

-The Day to Oust Evil Spirits from Your House-February 3rd (Sun)



What is Setsubun?

Setsubun is the day before the beginning of spring. Originally it meant the day before the beginning of spring, summer, autumn and winter. Now, it means only the day before the beginning of spring, which is the day of the start of the year in the lunar calendar.

What people do on this day?

On this day, people scatter parched soybeans, shouting "Oni-wa Soto, Fuku-wa Uchi" which means "Out with the devil! In with good fortune!" to get rid of evil spirits.

Usually the head of a family scatters the soybeans, but recently somebody in the family puts on the ogre mask and others throw the soybeans at the person. When you throw them, start with the innermost room and proceed to the front of the house.

After that people eat parched soybeans (eat the same number as your age), because it's said that if you eat them you can be healthy for the year.

What else do people eat?

Recently, people also eat a whole "Futo-maki / Eho-maki" (you shouldn't cut it) facing the good luck direction of the year, in silence. When you eat it, invoke your wish. (The good direction for 2012 is north-northwest.)

What do people decorate?

Depending on the area, people put a grilled sardine head and a holly branch at their front door as good-luck charms. They think devils run away because of the bad smell of grilled sardine and the holly thorns.



* The dates above depend on the lunar calendar, so they change every year.

Fortune-telling

February 1 ~ February 28

Forgiving people makes you calm and happy. It also makes you improve. Using the right side of your brain is also good: paint pictures, sing songs or dance.

February Birthday:

October Birthday:

Just saying things doesn't mean anything. You need to make things come true. Teamwork is the key for success.

November Birthday:

When you feel stress, remember to breathe deeply. It calms you down and makes your mind clear.

December Birthday:

If you have a difficult choice, think it over with a night of good sleep.

If there is no solution, just let it go.
